## New Business:

### Milling Brook bus shelter;

Councillor Kath Harris brought to the attention of the meeting the fact that the bus shelter at Milling Brook is in need of some remedial work. She also raised the possibility of a seat being placed in the area of the old road known locally as Lambeth walk. Furthermore she reported that a road sign up near Prior's Lodge is broken & that the Bus Stop sign at the top of Stockwell Lane also needs attention.

### Old road;

Cllr Bloomfield reported that the area between Stockwell Lane & Sandford road along which many people walk is getting very overgrown. Cannon as the local highways representative may be prevailed upon to assist with clearing but if not alternative arrangements must be made.

### Milling Brook path;

Following a complaint from a resident of Milling Crescent as to the condition of the path Cllrs Praker & Edwards had visited the site & reported that it was not as bad as had been suggested. However Cannon were contacted to appraise them of the situation as well as requesting that they maintain the area of grass by the brook itself and indeed to report the sorry condition of the village verges etc in general.
