General Business & Public concerns:

The school gave an account of how they had built a canopy but new white boards were needed and any donations would be welcome. School doing well, not many spaces available.

Bob Berryman. The Village Hall has had many improvements. There has been a loss of revenue due to a bad tenant. One member pursuing estate agent to try to recover the losses of 2000 for the rent and another 2000 for refurbishment.

He also spoke on behalf of Bathurst pool.. All doing well and thanks the council for it's support. He also mentioned that the village hall committee were appointing a law firm to deal with access to the playing field via Wesley Close.

A member of the methodist church thanks the council for it's donation but did say that further funding was needed for the second stage of the church refurbishment.
